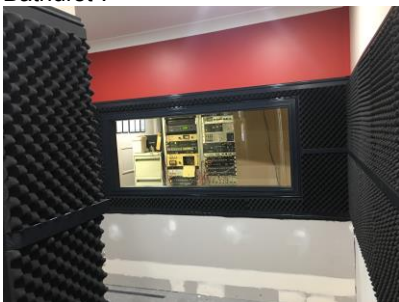
Coverage will also include the three games of the State of Origin Series.
