## 2BS 80 YEARS – THE 1980'S

In the early 1980's 2BS was in the middle of a broadcast network that included 2LF Young and 2MG Mudgee.

The majority of programs came from 2BS.

By the mid 1980's, 2BS was again a standalone radio station and with Kerry Peck on the breakfast program, Luke Bona moved from Young to begin a new morning talk program – the Morning Wireless Program which he hosted for more than 15 years.

Around this time 2BS also moved to Stereo AM Transmission and we got into computers with two Apple 2E's powering the program department.
