

Official Contest Rules & Regulations CKQK-FM CHARLOTTETOWN | HOT 105.5 The \$10,000 HOT Hunt (the 'Contest')

- 1. **Dates/Terms/Eligibility.** CKQK-FM (HOT 105-5) Newcap Radio Inc. (the "Station") has set an expiry date of Saturday, September 30, 2017 for **The \$10,000 HOT Hunt** (the "Contest"), however it reserves the right to terminate or extend the contest at any time. Any material changes will be broadcast on the Station and posted on its official website (www.HOT1055FM.com), within the Contest section. The Contest is open to legal Canadian Residents and students 18 years of age or older, residing in the province of Prince Edward Island. There is no purchase necessary to participate or to win. Employees or agents of the Station, all other Newcap Radio stations in Canada, or any entity associated with the Contest, as well as members of the same household of any such employee or agent may not participate.
- 2. **Prize.** There is one Grand Prize to be won. The value of the Grand Prize is \$10,000 CAD. The odds of winning the Grand Prize will depend on the number of listeners who participate and the number of items that the participants collect. The Grand Prize is non transferable or exchangeable and may not be substituted, except by sponsors for reasons of unavailability. In which case, a prize of equal or greater value will be awarded. The Station assumes no responsibility or liability for damages, loss, or injury resulting from acceptance or use of the Prize. The Grand Prize draw will be done on Monday, October 2, 2017.
- 3. **How To Enter.** Starting Monday, September 4, 2017 we'll encourage listeners to tune into HOT 105-5 weekdays (Monday-Friday) at approximately 7am, 8am, 11am, and 4pm to hear what item or task has to be collected, completed or documented to earn one entry for the Grand Prize draw. On Saturday, September 30, 2017 listeners will be invited to submit each item to our judges panel at an event held at The HOT 105.5 Studio at 176 Great George Street in Charlottetown beginning at 10am until 2pm. Each item that is presented to the panel and deemed a valid entry will earn the participant one ballot for the Grand Prize draw. Items and tasks must be obtained by obeying laws and it is the responsibility of the participant to be safe and avoid any situation that may put them in way of harming themselves or others. Any person who participates or tries to participate in the Contest

- releases the The Station and The Contest Sponsors from any and all liability for damages which he/she could suffer from participating or trying to participate in the Contest.
- 4. **Conditions/Restrictions**. In order to be declared a 'Winner', the selected participant(s) will be required to correctly answer, unaided, a time-limited, mathematical skill-testing question, to be administered by the Station. The Winner will be required to produce identification satisfactory to the Station. They will also be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and release, including a publicity release as prepared by the Station prior to receiving their Prize. The Winner will be responsible for any additional taxes or fees that result from the receipt and/or use of their Prize. The Contest is void where prohibited by law. Anyone using fraudulent means to participate and/or win the Contest will be disqualified. The Station is not responsible for errors, problems or delays in the mail, telephone or online web systems that may prevent listeners from participating In the Contest. In exchange for the right to participate in the Contest, each participant agrees to release and indemnify the Station, Newcap Radio and its officers, directors, agents, parent companies, subsidiaries and employees (the "Released Parties"), from any and all claims, demands and/or causes of action of any nature or kind whatsoever, whether presently known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, that arise out of the participant's participation in the Contest.
- 6. **Rules**. This contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws. By entering, each participant agrees to abide by these rules and regulations and the decisions of the Station judges which are final with respect to all aspects of the contest. Any violation of these rules will result in disqualification.
