

EVACUATION ORDER

Dutch Valley

June 4, 2021, at 14:30 hrs

Pursuant to [Section 12 (1) of the BC Emergency Program Act] an **Evacuation Order** has been issued by Regional District of Kitimat-Stikine due to immediate danger to life safety caused by flooding

Members of the local police department and other agencies and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

All properties within the Community of Dutch Valley South of Dutch Valley Road (please refer to map for specific areas)

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

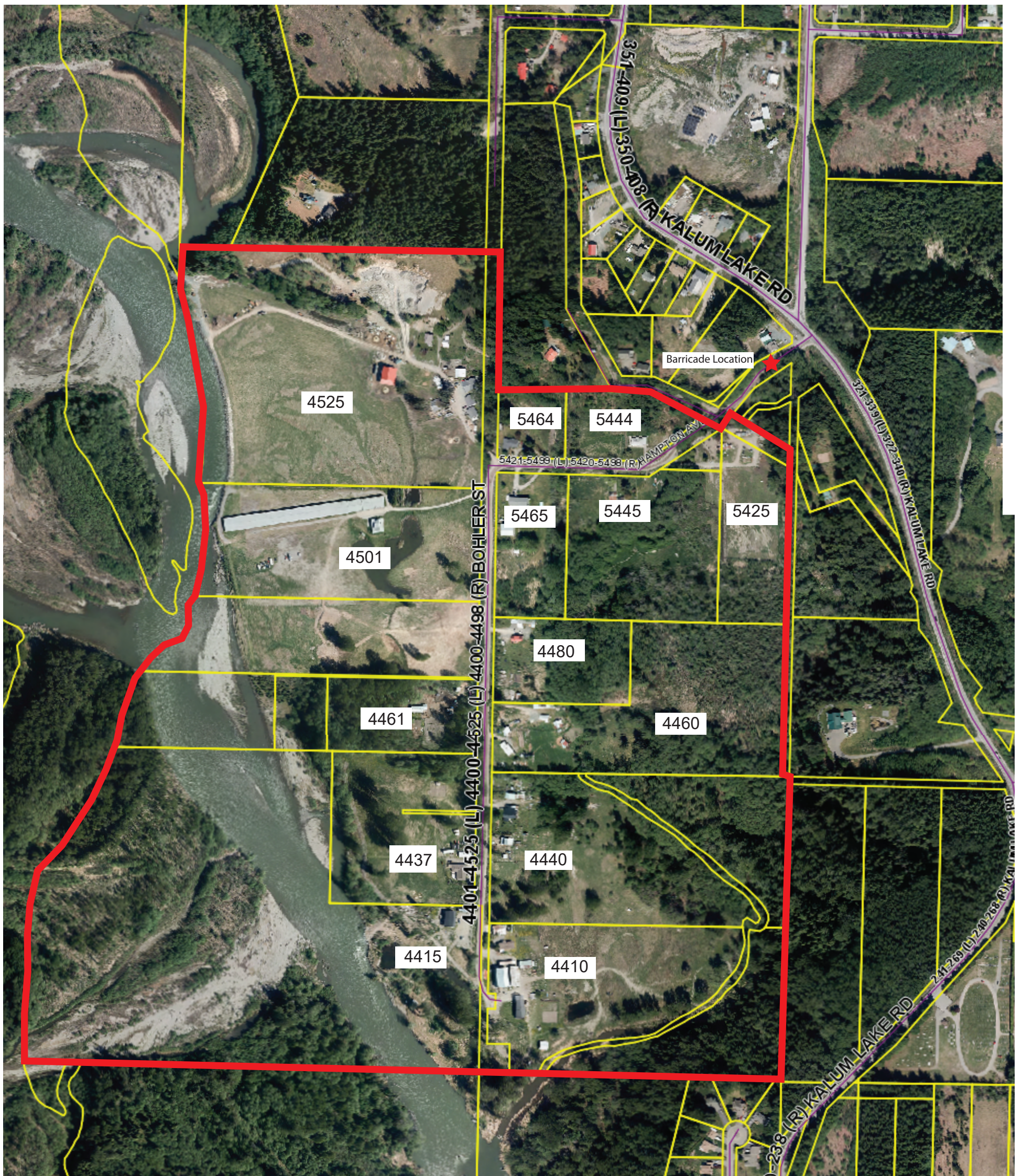
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Follow the travel route provided and register at: ESS Reception Centre at the Thornhill Community Center 3091 Century Street.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call 250-641-2443
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.
