

PRAISE Concert in the Park FAQs

Updated 7/24/18

When is the event?

Sunday, July 29th from 4 – 8PM. Food and activities start at 4PM and music starts at 5:30.

Admission is free?

Yes! This is a FREE event for PRAISE listeners and the general public.

Are tickets required?

No.

Where is it?

On the Barkley Village Green, directly outside of the PRAISE 106.5 Offices, at:
2215 Rimland Drive, Bellingham WA, 98226

Sorry, PRAISE cannot offer station tours at this time. The office buildings will be closed to the public.

Where do I park?

There is free parking in the large paved lots directly NORTH of the park. *Please enter this area from Woburn Street, and turn East on Burns Street.* There will be large flags and signage directing you into the parking area off of Woburn Street.

Is there reserved seating?

No. This is general seating and is open to the public. There are no reserved seats and chairs are not provided.

You are welcome to bring a blanket or low back/beach style folding chair, keeping in mind:

- Blankets should be no more than 5' wide or long.
- Chairs must be low-back/beach style chairs only
- Depending on attendance, you may be asked to limit the footprint of your blanket to accommodate other guests.

Is there park access for disabled persons?

Yes, the park is wheelchair-accessible from the Southeast corner of the grassy area.

Are there restrooms on-site?

Yes. Outdoor portable toilets and a hand wash station will be provided for guests. The office buildings will be closed to the general public.

Are food or beverages available?

- Yes! There will be 3-4 food vendors on-site offering a variety of entrees, snacks, desserts, and beverages available for purchase.
- There are also many quick-service restaurants and a Haggen grocery store nearby if you want to purchase food off-site.
- Please plan to use U.S. Cash for any purchases from food vendors, although some *might* accept cards or Canadian currency.

Can I bring my own food or beverages?

Yes, but please no large coolers. Also, BBQs/grills are not allowed. See "General Event Policies" below for more details.

I heard there will be free Pepsi products?

Yes. Our event sponsor, Walton Beverage, is generously providing a free can/bottle of Pepsi product to the first 250 guests. Look for a table and signs to request your free drink when you arrive.

Is there a drinking water station available?

Sorry, drinking water will not be provided on-site. You are welcome to bring your own, or the food vendors should also have bottled water available for purchase.

Are the kids' activities free?

PRAISE is providing an inflatable bouncy house FREE of charge to kids ages 7 and younger. Parents will need to sign a liability waiver before kids will be allowed to use the inflatables. There will also be other lawn games and activities available free of charge.

What happens if it rains? Is there shade?

The event will be held rain or shine. Umbrellas will be allowed for rain only, and should be used near the back of the viewing areas. See "other event policies" below for more details.

This is in an open park with no overhead cover, so plan accordingly for weather conditions. Sunscreen and/or hats are recommended for sunny weather. Light coats or rain jackets are recommended for rain.

Is there a baby changing area? Nursing area?

No, sorry, those facilities are not available at this event.

Can I bring my dog?

Well-mannered dogs on leashes are welcome. Please be a responsible pet parent and keep them close to you at all times, and ensure they are not a distraction to the other guests. Also, keep in mind there will be loud live music and lots of children.

For bathroom "duties," we ask that pets be taken to the grassy area directly south (downhill) of the park, or in the gravel parking area in the Southwest corner. Ask a staff member if you need directions.

Will there be a "meet and greet"?

No. The main act (Micah Tyler) will not be available for pictures or a meet and greet.

General Event Policies:

- No alcohol will be served by food vendors, and is not allowed at the event.
- No smoking, smokeless tobacco, or vaping/e-cigarettes will be allowed in the park. Smoking or vaping will be allowed in the North parking areas only.
- No weapons of any kind are allowed.
- No BBQs, grills, or "tailgate" cooking allowed in the park or parking lots.
- Shelters, canopies, tents, and/or personal tables are not allowed in the park area.
- This is a family-friendly event. Visitors are expected to be courteous and respectful to one another and conduct themselves in a proper manner.
