2,000

families can stay with us each year in our 73-bedroom House.

497 Nights: the longest consecutive stay by a guest family.

7% had a child in the NICU

4% had a child treated for mental health

Staying at RMH BC costs only **\$12** a night for the entire family.

\$6,000: How much a family can save per month when they stay at RMH BC.

32% of our families stay with us twice or more each year. The most stays by one family in 2018 was **13** stays.



RMH BC is 575 steps to BC Children's Hospital, keeping families close to care.



Community groups served **222** home cooked meals to our families in 2018.

334 hours of music therapy were provided by our accredited music therapist.





384 hours of art therapy were provided by our accredited art therapist.


Countless puppy cuddles were made possible through our dog therapy program.
