support, Emergency Response Team (ERT) MembersCommunities <20km:</th>St. George's Hill, Michel Village, Dillon and Buffalo River Dene FN

Crews are maintaining values protection units, working the perimeter and establishing dozer lines around Dillon. Crews working on hotspots around St. George's Hill.
