Proposed Bicycle Lanes

Restriction of on-street parking is proposed to accommodate bicycle lanes on the following City streets:

We kindly request all comments be submitted no later than March 15, 2018.

- **Avondale Road** - Harder Drive to Meagher Place
- **Harder Drive**
- **Palmer Road** - Harder Drive to Bridge Street West
- **Station Street** - Cannifton Road Parkway to Farley Avenue
- **Herchimer Avenue** - Dundas Street West to Station Street

Proposed Bicycle Routes

The following roadways will continue to be shared roadways but would become designated cycling routes. Shared Roadways signed as Bicycle Routes do not require any Traffic Control By-Law revisions.

- Grosvenor Drive, Kensington Crescent
- Wellington Street, Parker Street, Highland Avenue
- Catharine Street
- Centre Street
- Foster Avenue / South Foster Avenue

Subject to comments received and Council approval of Traffic By-Law amendments, line painting, signage and shoulder paving would proceed this year.
