SERIES NOTES VS. PENGUINS

All-Time Wild Record: 13-11-1 (6-5-1 at Xcel Energy Center, 7-6-0 at Pittsburgh)

2018-19: Minnesota lost both season meetings against Pittsburgh, 2-1, at PPG Paints Arena (12/20) and, 3-2, at Xcel Energy Center (12/31)...C Charlie Coyle (0-2=2) and C **Mikko Koivu** (1-1=2) led the Wild with two points apiece...G **Devan Dubnyk** went 0-2-0 with a 2.55 GAA and a .928 SV% in two starts...RW Phil Kessel led the Penguins with three points (1-2=3)...C **Sidney Crosby** (1-1=2), RW **Bryan Rust** (2-0=2) and LW **Jake Guentzel** (0-2=2) each tallied two points...G **Casey DeSmith** went 2-0-0 with a 1.50 GAA and a .959 SV% in two starts.

WILD LEADERS: C **Eric Staal** leads the Wild with 54 points (23-31=54) in 55 games vs. the Penguins...LW **Zach Parise** has 40 points (17-23=40) in 52 contests...RW **Mats Zuccarello** owns 20 points (6-14=20) in 29 matches...Koivu owns 11 points (5-6=11) in 19 games...D **Ryan Suter** has nine points (1-8=9) in 17 contests.

WILD GOALIES: Dubnyk is 5-7-0 with a 2.87 GAA and a .914 SV% in 12 career starts against Pittsburgh...G **Alex Stalock** is 0-0-1 with a 2.64 GAA and a .907 SV% in three games (one start).

PENGUINS LEADERS: Crosby leads the Penguins with 21 points (6-15=21) in 17 games vs. the Wild...C **Evgeni Malkin** owns 16 points (7-9=16) in 14 matches...D **Jack Johnson** has 16 points (4-12=16) in 32 contests...RW **Patric Hornqvist** owns 12 points (6-6=12) in 26 games.

PENGUINS GOALIES: G **Matt Murray** is 1-1-0 with a 1.51 GAA and a .945 SV% in two career starts against Minnesota...G **Tristan Jarry** has not faced the Wild.

CONNECTIONS: Minnesota General Manager **Bill Guerin** totaled 57 points (26-31=57) in 95 games with Pittsburgh in two seasons (2008-10), winning the Stanley Cup in 2009...Guerin then spent eight seasons in the Penguins front office (2011-19), including five seasons (2014-19) as Assistant General Manager where he won two more Stanley Cups (2016, 2017)...C **Nick Bjugstad** is a native of Minneapolis and played two seasons at the University of Minnesota (2010-12)...Crosby played at Shattuck St. Mary's (2002-03)...Guentzel played high school hockey at Hill-Murray.

FAST FACTS: Minnesota's season sweep vs. Pittsburgh in 2016-17 was the first time the Wild swept the Penguins in a season series since 2009-10.

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Wild return home after its season opening three-game road trip, Oct. 3-10. Minnesota is one of the last three NHL teams to hold its home opener Saturday (Boston, Los Angeles).

- Minnesota is 14-0-4 in its first game of the season at Xcel Energy Center – including a tie in its first-ever home game. The Wild is the only team without a regulation loss in their first game at their traditional home arena (NHL Stats).

- Per NHL Stats, the Wild (.833; 13-1-4 in 18 GP) ranks first in League history in point percentage in home openers.

- Saturday's contest marks Minnesota's first home opener against Pittsburgh, eighth time against an Eastern Conference opponent (4-1-2).

- Minnesota plays 17 of its first 26 games of the season on the road (Oct. 3-Nov. 30). The nine home games in October and November are the fewest in franchise history.

FACING THE EAST

- Beginning Saturday, Minnesota begins a five-game stretch against an Eastern Conference opponent (Oct. 12-20), including four games against a Canadian team.
- This is the fourth consecutive season the Wild will face an Eastern team for at least five straight games. The five-game stretch is tied for the third-longest in franchise history.
- **Eric Staal** leads Minnesota with 720 career points against an Eastern Conference opponent (307-413=720). He ranks second amongst active NHL players in shots (2,736), fourth in goals, SHG (15) and points, fifth in GWG (49) and sixth in assists and PPG (94) against the East.

ALL-STAR GOALIE

- **Devan Dubnyk** stopped 28-of-31 shots on Oct. 3, his 300th career game in a Wild sweater. He became the second goaltender in team history to play in 300-plus games (Niklas Backstrom, 409) and the 15th active NHL goalie to play in 300-plus games with a single franchise. He also sits at 296 career starts with Minnesota, only Backstrom has had more starts in team history (391).
- The native of Regina, Saskatchewan, is the only Wild player to represent the team three times at the NHL All-Star (2019, 2017 & 2016).
- Last season, he led the NHL in games played (67), tying his career high, and ranked T-1st in road wins (19).
- He is one of three goalies in the NHL to win 30 games in each of the last five seasons (Holtby, Rinne).

OFFENSE BY DEFENSE

- Minnesota has totaled 14 points in its three games this season (6-8=14), seven of those points (3-4=7) have been collected by the defensemen. Minnesota ranks first in the NHL in percentage of goals, assists and points totaled by defensemen (50.0%).
- The Wild led the NHL in PPG (16) and percentage of goals scored by defensemen (20.9%) and ranked fifth in goals scored (44) by defensemen last season.
- Minnesota blueliners totaled 150 of the team's 571 points, ranking T-5th in the NHL at 26.3%.

SUTE UP

- **Ryan Suter** is in his 15th NHL season, one of 13 active defensemen skating in their 15th-plus NHL season. He ranks sixth amongst active NHL blueliners in games played (1,076).
- He notched two points (1-1=2) at COL (10/5), his 100th career multi-point game – per NHL Stats, he became the ninth active NHL defenseman to record 100-plus multi-point games.
- He led the NHL in TOI/game at 26:42 last season – the fourth time in the last seven seasons he has led the NHL in TOI/game.
- The Madison, Wisc., native ranks second amongst active NHL defensemen (460) and second in franchise history (260) in assists.

DUMBA RETURNS

- **Matt Dumba** returned to action in the Wild season opener at NSH (10/3) after missing the last 50 games of the 2018-19 season due to a tear in his right pectoralis muscle and netted his first goal since Dec. 11, 2018. The goal marked the ninth time a Wild defenseman tallied a goal in a season opening game.
- He led NHL defensemen in goals (12) and PPG (6) and ranked T-6th in shots (93) at the time of his injury (12/15/18).
- The blueliner is one of five defensemen since 2005-06 to have three consecutive 10-plus goal seasons before the age of 24.
- The Regina, Saskatchewan native, owns 152 career points (57-95=152) in 345 contests with the Wild. He sits one overtime goal from tying for first for most overtime goals in franchise history (Koivu & Burns, 5) and three PPG shy and two GWG from tying Burns/Spurgeon for most by a Wild defenseman (26 and 13, respectively).

IN THE HUNT

- **Brad Hunt** netted his first goal of the season and a game-high six shots Thursday at WPG. He owns two points (1-1=2) in three games this season.
- Since being acquired by Minnesota on Jan. 21, he has seven points (4-3=7) in a Wild sweater, five of those points have come on the power-play (3-2=5). He owns 41 points (11-30=41) in 123 career NHL games, including 24 power-play points (8-16=24).
- The Maple Ridge, British Columbia native, signed a two-year, \$1.4 million contract on June 24. He recorded 12 points (5-7=12) in 42 games with the Vegas Golden Knights and Minnesota during the 2018-19 season.

SWEET SIXTEEN

- **Jason Zucker** scored the Wild's first goal (PPG) of the 2019-20 season. The goal marked his first goal in a season opening contest.
- In his last 10 regular season games in which he scored, Zucker has been the Wild's first goal of a game seven times, totaling 13 goals (6 PPG) in those 10 contests (Dec. 22, 2018-Oct. 3, 2019).
- The Las Vegas, native, set career highs in PPG with seven in each of the last two seasons.
- The winger was named the recipient of the 2019 King Clancy Memorial Trophy on June 19. He became the third player in Wild history

to win a voted-on NHL Award and received \$40,000 in donation from the NHL Foundation to the Zucker Family Suite and Broadcast Studio at the University of Minnesota Masonic Children's Hospital.

IS IT OCTOBER YET?

- Minnesota has posted an all-time 95-65-30 record for the month of October, including a 36-21-10 record in the last six seasons – tied for fourth-fewest October losses in the NHL since 2013.
- Wild goaltenders rank first in the NHL since 2000 in October GAA (2.52), T-1st in SV% (.914) and T-2nd in shutouts (17).
- **Mikko Koivu** leads the team with 95 career points (26-69=95) in the month of October. No other Wild player has reached 100 points in October in team history. In fact, Koivu has reached 100-plus points in each month except October (excluding April). Marian Gaborik is the sole Wild player with 100-plus points in a single month all-time (March, 102).

SELLOUT STREAK

- Minnesota has sold out 229 consecutive regular season games at Xcel Energy Center. The last regular season game that was not a sellout was Dec. 2, 2013 vs. Philadelphia. Minnesota has registered 736 all-time sellouts at home, including 670 regular season matches.

Head Coach: Bruce Boudreau

Bruce Boudreau (boo-DROH) is in his fourth season as Minnesota Wild Head Coach after being named to the position May 7, 2016. He's 540-282-108 (.638) in 12 seasons as an NHL head coach, including 131-90-28 (.582) with the Wild and has led his team to eight division titles. Boudreau coached the Central Division at the 2017 NHL All-Star Game for the first time in team history and first time in his career. He's the first coach in NHL history to lead 3 different teams to win streaks of 11+ games, the fastest coach in NHL history to reach 400 wins (663 games, 3/5/16), the second-fastest coach to reach 500 wins (837 games, 3/24/18) and is 2nd amongst active coaches in pt %. Boudreau went 208-104-40 (.647) with Anaheim (2011-16) and led the Ducks to four straight Pacific Division titles (2012-16). He went 201-88-40 (.672) with Washington, winning the Southeast Division four times (2007-11) and the 2008 Jack Adams Award.

DOWN BUT NOT OUT

Despite only being four games into the 2019-20 season, the Penguins have been decimated by injuries to key players. Forwards **Nick Bjugstad**, **Alex Galchenyuk**, **Evgeni Malkin** and **Bryan Rust**, who are all sidelined due to various injuries, combined to score 72 goals, 102 assists, 174 points and 15 game-winning goals in 2018-19.

In their absence on Thursday, Penguins captain **Sidney Crosby** stepped up in a big way, scoring a power-play goal early in the second period, and then making a beautiful pass to linemate **Jake Guentzel** in the slot for the game-winner midway through the third period. Crosby has points in all four games this season (2G-4A) which includes two multi-point efforts, both in Pittsburgh's wins. He has also figured in on four of the Penguins last five goals.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Goaltender **Matt Murray** is expected to make his first road start of the 2019-20 campaign this weekend. Last year, Murray was one of the top goalies in the NHL while playing away from PPG Paints Arena. In 25 road games last season, he went 16-4-4 with a 2.27 goals-against average and a .931 save percentage.

Murray finished in the top-10 in road wins (T-5th), points percentage (T-2nd), goals-against average (T-7th) and save percentage (T-4th) among goalies who appeared in at least 15 road games.

JARRY LOOKS TO MAKE 1ST APPEARANCE OF 2019-20

Penguins backup netminder **Tristan Jarry** is looking to see his first game action of the 2019-20 campaign in this weekend's back-to-back games against Minnesota and Winnipeg. Jarry, who went 0-0-2 in two preseason games, has 29 games of NHL experience from 2016-19 with a 14-8-3 record, 2.84 goals-against average and a .906 save percentage.

Last season, Jarry spent the majority of his time as the starting goalie for the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins of the AHL, where he compiled a 23-15-8 record, 2.66 goals-against average, a .915 save percentage and one shutout. He also became the first goalie in WBS history, and 14th goalie in AHL history, to score a goal when he shot the puck from his crease down into the Springfield Thunderbirds' empty net on November 14, 2018.

MURRAY CLOSING IN ON 100 WINS

Penguins goaltender **Matt Murray**, who currently sits at 99 career wins, is looking to join **Marc-Andre Fleury** (375), **Tom Barrasso** (226) and **Ken Wregget** (104) as the only netminders in Penguins history to win 100 games with the team.
