**RECAP:** Casey Cizikas and Matt Martin scored 2:05 apart midway through the third period to lead the Islanders to a 2-0 win over the Rangers Monday night at Madison Square Garden. Semyon Varlamov made 30 saves for this third shutout of the season.

### 2021 SEASON:

- The New York Islanders are apart of the East Division and set to play 56 games against only divisional oppoents (BOS, BUF, NJD, NYR, PHI, PIT, WSH). They will play all seven divisional opponents eight times this season.

- The recently-announced schedule change means that the Islanders will play the same opponent in consecutive games nineteen times this season.

- The New York Islanders will not play a single game outside of the Eastern Time zone for the first time in franchise history.

#### TONIGHT:

- The New York Islanders are 112-104-22-18 all-time against the Penguins and 66-42-8-11 at home.
- This is the second of six meetings between the two teams in February, and second of four at Nassau Coliseum.
- The Islanders are 3-0-0 at home this season and look to win their first four home games for the first time since 1984-85.
- **Brock Nelson** has 299 points - only 21 other Islanders have reached the 300 point mark (one of those being **Anders Lee**, 307).
- **Lou Lamoriello** is one win shy of 1,300 as an NHL general manger. He would become the third in NHL history to reach the milestone (D. Poile - 1,420 &G. Sather - 1,319).

#### THIS SEASON:

- **Barry Trotz** earned his 850th career win as an NHL head coach and surprised Ken Hitchcock (849) for sole possession on the league's all-time list. He is second among active coaches, trailing only Joel Quenneville, in both wins and games (850-622-60-153, 1,685 GP).
- **Lou Lamoriello** and **Barry Trotz** have 2,149 combined wins, the most by any general manager/head coach duo in NHL history.
- Goaltender **Semyon Varlamov** leads the league with three shutouts. He became the second Islanders goaltender with three shutouts before his 10th appearance in a season (T. Salo, 1998-99). His shutout on Feb. 8 at NYR was his 30th NHL career shutout, making him the 5th Russian goaltender to hit that milestone.
- **Mathew Barzal** has 12 points (4g, 8a) in 11 games and points on 12 of the team's 25 goals, including nine of 18 at even strength. Barzal holds a six-game assist streak - only C. McDavid (8), M. Marner (8) and C. McAvoy (7) have longer active streaks.
- The Islanders rank third in the league with a 53.8 FOW%. They won a majority of face-offs in each of the first five games for the first time in franchise history.
- The Islanders have three shutouts in their first 11 games for the first time since 1998-99.
- **Andy Greene** leads the team with 26 blocked shots this season. He is the fifth active NHL player with at least 1,800 career blocked shots.
- **Semyon Varlamov** played in his 500th NHL career game on Feb. 6 vs. PIT, becoming the 3rd goalie to appear in his 500th NHL game as an Islander (B. Smith &D. Roloson). He is the 13th currently-active goaltender to appear in 500 games.
- **Anders Lee** has ranks 9th on the Islanders all-time list with 53 power play goals. Three of his four goals this season have come on the power play.
- **Josh Bailey** recorded his 324th career assist on Jan. 31 at PHI, breaking a tie with Brent Sutter for 8th on the Islanders all-time list.
- **Josh Bailey** ranks 4th on the franchise's all-time games played list (876). Bailey can move into third place on the list by the end of this season.

- **Anders Lee** appeared in his 500th NHL game (all for the Islanders) on Jan. 28 at WSH. The Islanders dressed five skaters with 500 games of Islanders experience for the first time since April 6, 1986 (Bailey, Martin, Nelson, Cizikas & Lee).

- **Oliver Wahlstrom** recorded his first NHL goal on Jan. 28 at WSH, becoming the 379th player in Islanders history to score a goal. Wahlstrom and **Noah Dobson** (1A) are the first pair of Islanders to be born in the 2000s to record points in the same period.

- The Islanders allowed just one shot on goal in the third period on Jan. 28 at WSH, tying a club record (most recently done on Jan. 11, 2017)

- **Noah Dobson** played 20:24 on Thursday, Jan. 21 vs. NJD, tying a career-high. He recorded his first NHL multi-point game (2A) and blocked seven shots - matching the most by an Islander defenseman since Calvin deHaan had eight on Dec. 20, 2016 vs. BOS. He became the youngest Islander defenseman (21 years, 15 days) with a multi-point game (and a multi-assist game) since Travis Hamonic, who had four multi-point games as a 20-year-old and three multi-assist games as a 20-year-old.

- **Semyon Varlamov** recorded 27 saves on January 18 vs. BOS to become the first goaltender in Islanders history to record a shutout in each of his first two appearances of a season and just the 14th goaltender in NHL history to do so. **Varlamov's** season-opening shutout streak of 142:10 was the 8th longest scoreless streak to start a season in NHL history.

- **Anders Lee, Brock Nelson, Mathew Barzal** and **Ryan Pulock** are four Islanders who have active consecutive game streaks of at least 200 games (Lee 279, Nelson 256, Barzal 243, Pulock 206). Lee, Nelson & Barzal are three of 18 players in the NHL whose streak of 240+ consecutive games began no later than the start of the 2017-18 season. All five players have appeared in every game since Barry Trotz became the Islanders' coach.

- Islanders 2014 Third Round (78th overall) draft pick **Ilya Sorokin** made his NHL debut on January 16 at the New York Rangers, becoming the first goaltender in Islander history to make his NHL debut against the Rangers. He is also the first goalie to make his NHL debut as an Islander since Christopher Gibson (January 2, 2016), and the first Islander to start in his NHL debut since Jean-Francois Berube on October 10, 2015.

#### -----CAREER NOTES-----

- **Anders Lee** has the fourth-longest consecutive game streak (279) among all-time Islanders. **Brock Nelson** (6th) and **Mathew Barzal** (8th) have both moved into the top-10.

- Captain **Anders Lee** is in his third season as Islanders captain. Since his first full NHL season in 2013-14, Lee is tied for seventh among American-born players in career goals (175). Additionally, Lee ranks second among active players in career goals by players drafted in the 6th round.

- **Josh Bailey** is in his 13th season in the NHL, making him the longest tenured Islander on the roster.

- **Brock Nelson** is in his eighth season in the NHL. Brock Nelson led the Islanders in goals in both the 2019-20 regular season (26) and post-season (9, tied). Nelson, 29, took (1,188) and won (615) more faceoffs than anyone on the Islanders last season and finished above 50% (51.77%) in the face-off dot for the first time in his career.

- **Cal Clutterbuck** is the NHL's active leader in career hits (3,179). Clutterbuck, 33, skated in his 800th NHL game on Nov. 2, 2019 becoming the 11th player from his draft class to reach that milestone and just the second player drafted outside the first round.

- **Matt Martin** became the fifth active player to reach 3,000 career hits (one of whom is Cal Clutterbuck). Since making his NHL debut in the 2009-10 season, Martin leads the NHL in hits (3,027).

- **Andy Greene** is 56 games shy of reaching the 1,000 game milestone. He currently leads all active NHL undrafted players with 942 games played.

- **Noah Dobson** is the youngest player on the Islanders 23-man roster for the second straight season. He is one of just eight defensemen from the 2018 Draft class to have already made his NHL debut. He made his NHL debut on Oct. 8 vs. EDM and became the first NYI defenseman to record a point in his NHL debut since 2011 (M. Katic) and the first teenage defenseman to play for the Islanders since 1999 (M. Biron).

## New York Islanders: Head Coach and Player Bios

### Head Coach: Barry Trotz

Barry Trotz was named Head Coach of the New York Islanders on June 21, 2018. In his first two seasons, Trotz led the franchise to a combined regular season record of 83-50-17 and a combined playoff record of 17-13.

The Islanders earned 80 points and went 30-23-10 in 2019-20 in 68 games last season before the NHL COVID stoppage. The team set a franchise record 17-game point streak (15-0-2) from October 12 through November 28, 2019.

The Islanders have qualified for the Stanley Cup Playoffs in both of Trotz's first two seasons with the club. Trotz led the Islanders to a 13-9 postseason record in 2020, the most postseason wins by an Islanders team since 1982-83. The team advanced to the Eastern Conference Final for the first time since 1993.

Trotz finished the 2019-20 season in third place on the NHL's all-time games coached list (1,674) and fourth place on the NHL's all-time wins list (845). Trotz ranks second among active head coaches in both wins and games coached.

## **TEAM NOTES:**

### **FRONT OFFICE FRENZY**

On Tuesday, the Penguins made two huge additions to their hockey operations staff, naming **Ron Hextall** the 11th general manager in team history and **Brian Burke** president of hockey operations.

Hextall, 56, has been in NHL management for more than twenty years, including a four-year stint as general manager of the Philadelphia Flyers from 2014-18. He also was assistant general manager of the Los Angeles Kings from 2006-2013, helping the Kings to their first Stanley Cup in 2012.

Burke, 65 is a Harvard Law School graduate that has spent 31 years as an NHL executive, winning the Stanley Cup as general manager of the Anaheim Ducks in 2006-07. He also served as general manager of the Hartford Whalers and the Vancouver Canucks; president and general manager of the Toronto Maple Leafs; and president of hockey operations for the Calgary Flames. From 1993-98 he was executive vice president and director of hockey operations for the NHL, working closely with commissioner Gary Bettman.

**Patrik Allvin**, who briefly served as interim general manager, has resumed his role as assistant general manager under Hextall and Burke.

### **IN RUST WE TRUST**

Winger **Bryan Rust** has been one of Pittsburgh's most consistent performers through the first 11 games of the season. Rust has points in a team-best eight of 11 games this season (2G-6A) and his eight games with at least a point are tied for fifth-best in the East Division:

Rust also sits two assists shy of 100 in his career. Since making his NHL debut on Dec. 13, 2014, Rust ranks sixth on the Penguins in goals (80) and seventh in assists (98) and points (178).

### KING OF THE COLISEUM

Throughout his career, **Sidney Crosby** has played dominant hockey against the New York Islanders. In 68 career games, Crosby has recorded 114 points (36G-68A) against the Islanders, helping Pittsburgh to a 41-18-9 record in those games. He has more than double the amount of multi-point games against them (33) as opposed to games with no points (16), while his 114 total points ranks fourth in NHL history behind **Jaromir Jagr** (155), **Mario Lemieux** (131) and **Mark Recchi** (120).
