July 2020

Survey conducted July 18 through July 19, 2020. 3,600 likely 2020 General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2020 General Election.

Margin of Error is +/-2% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding.

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Q1: Do you approve or disapprove of the way the state of Louisiana has handled and responded to the COVID-19 pandemic?

Approve: 57%
Disapprove: 26%
Not sure: 17%

Q2: Do you approve or disapprove of how Louisiana hospitals have responded to the COVID-19 pandemic?

Approve: 70%
Disapprove: 15%
Not sure: 15%

Q3: In March, Governor Edwards declared a public health emergency for Louisiana, allowing Louisiana to coordinate with the federal government in response to COVID-19. Currently, there is a petition being circulated by members of the legislature to cancel the Governor's health emergency and fully open up Louisiana.
