Greetings:

As Governor of the State of Indiana, I certify the following:

In accordance with Article 2, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States, the Indiana General Assembly directed that the Electors for President and Vice-President of the United States be elected at the General Election Conducted on November 8, 2016.

On the Twenty-ninth day of November, 2016, in accordance with Indiana Code 3-12-5-7, following the receipt of certified statements from each circuit court clerk of the state, prepared and delivered by the clerk to the Secretary of State of the State of Indiana in accordance with state law, setting forth the number of votes cast in each county for Electors for President and Vice-President of the United States at the General Election, the Secretary of State of Indiana did canvass and compare the number of votes cast for Electors for President and Vice-President of the United States.
