

# COVID-19 SAFE TRICK-OR-TREATING

- Stay home if you are sick, and do not hand out candy if you are sick.
- Trick or treat with your household only.
- Practice social distancing by remaining 6 feet apart from people not in your household.
- Wear a face covering under or over your Halloween costume that covers both your mouth and nose.
- Do not directly hand out candy; instead, place candy in a large bowl or spread out on a table on your front porch.
- Have hand sanitizer to use often, before eating, and after coughing/sneezing.
- Avoid public interaction with high-risk groups both in their home and at nursing home facilities.
- If you are a high-risk individual, follow trick-or-treating tradition by leaving your porch light off to avoid public interaction.



Appleton Health Department is supportive of trick-or-treating with community education around safe practices. Large events and gatherings are still not recommended at this time.
