Tuckpoint West Side of Building

- Many areas of the exterior walls are in very poor condition due to deterioration of the mortar.
- Water infiltration has occurred frequently during inclement weather. This causes additional deterioration during winter freeze / thaw.
- The plan is to do the entire High School in sections starting with the west side first. Many areas have no mortar left between joints.

Concrete Football Bleachers

- Concrete has deteriorated beyond repair. It is past its end of life.
- This has created safety hazards.
- The tunnels will need attention as well before both become unsafe to use.

Resurface All-Weather Track

- The track is peeling and bubbling up in many areas causing a hazard to athletes.
- Existing track has reached its end of life.

Security Audit - February 2020

Recommendation Items to be Done:

- **Add additional cameras throughout building.**
- **Upgrade majority of analog cameras to digital cameras.**
- **Add an additional camera server to increase recording retention and accommodate additional cameras.**
- **Add required networking equipment to support new camera equipment.**

Cannon Demolition

- Cannon was declared unsafe for occupancy in 2015.
- Since 2015, the deterioration has continued at a rapid pace.
- Cannon is a safety and liability issue for the District.
- Since Cannon is an unoccupied building, historically, only one property/casualty insurance carrier has been willing to provide coverage for the building.
