### **Important Updates**

Slightly higher snowfall amounts, mainly in the Winter Storm Warning area.


#### **What We Know**

- → Significant snowfall expected Saturday.
- → Snow begins after midnight and ends Saturday after 6pm.
- → Peak snow rates from 7 AM to 2 PM.
- → Dangerous wind chills -15 to -30 much of tonight into Sunday morning.

### **Winter Storm Warning Details**




Much of Saturday. 3am - Midnight



#### Combination of:

- → Snow totals of 4" to 10", locally higher
- → Blowing and drifting snow
- → Peak snow rates 7 AM to 2 PM
- → \*Dangerous wind chills

\*\*\* Winter Weather Advisory and Wind Chill Advisory in effect north of the Warning area\*\*\*





## **Forecast Snowfall**

Periods of Heavy Snow


#### **Winter Weather Details**

- → 35-60% chance of 6" or more along I-80, including Omaha and Lincoln. 60-85% chance of 6" or more south of I-80.
  - ◆ Localized 12" totals possible in highlighted area.
- → Peak snowfall rates near 1 inch per hour for several hours along and south of Interstate 80.
- → Snow will be light and fluffy, resulting in prolonged blowing and drifting.

### **Impacts**





- → Hazardous travel expected

- → Severely reduced visibilities






## Chance of 6" and 8"

# **Bitterly Cold Wind Chills**


Dangerous Cold Expected Tonight Into Sunday Morning

### **Wind Chill Advisory**

- → Hazardous wind chills tonight through Sunday.
- → Lowest readings Saturday and Sunday mornings.
- → Wind chills for New Year's Eve celebrations will range from 0 to 29 below (6 PM Fri to 12 AM Sat).
- → Northerly wind gusts of 25 to 35 mph are expected Saturday morning.

### What Can I Do?

- → Keep skin covered
- → Dress in layers
- → Limit outdoor activity and keep pets inside

## **Expected Wind Gust Timeline**

### Wind

- → The strongest winds are expected on Saturday with gusts of 35-40 mph.
- → Wind direction will be from the north.
- → The wind combined with the fluffy snow consistency will result in a prolonged period of blowing snow, and resulting visibility restrictions.
- → Winds will diminish on Saturday night into Sunday morning.
