Winter Weather Advisory expanded slightly and extended until 1 pm.


Key Messages

- Hazardous travel due to low visibility, crosswinds, and slick roadways.
- Beneficial precipitation for the entire region.

Snowfall Today

Event Confidence:


This is a lower confidence, but potentially high impact snow event. Where snow falls conditions may be hazardous.

Snowfall Details:

- Snowfall rates may exceed 1 inch per hour
- Snowfall of 1 to 4 inches. Isolated higher amounts POSSIBLE in parts of the yellow enclosed area
- Blowing snow due to wind gusts up to 45 mph at times

Travel Hazards:

- Near blizzard conditions possible in areas of heaviest snowfall
- Slick and slushy snow covered roads






Peak Wind Gusts Today

What to Expect:

Strong northerly winds will persistent throughout today.

Other Considerations:

- •Reduced visibilities in blowing snow
- •Unsecured outdoor objects may be blown around
- •Strong crosswinds for travelers on Interstate 80






Winter Storm Severity Index

Expected Impact Level

Some impacts are expected along and west of a line from Onawa to Hebron.


Potential Impacts


- Areas of near blizzard conditions possible.
- Slick and slushy snow covered roads.
- Deteriorating travel conditions for east-west travelers along Interstate 80 west of Lincoln due to combination of snow and wind.
- No significant impacts anticipated for the commute in Omaha or Lincoln due to snow.





Probability of Greater Than 0.1" or 1" of Snow







