What to Know:

→ Friday:

- ◆ **Extreme** Fire Danger likely within the Fire Weather Watch. Very High category elsewhere.
- ◆ North winds 20 to 30 mph gusting to 50 mph.
- ◆ Minimum RH values as low as 17 percent.
- ◆ Fire Weather Watch from Noon to 9 PM.

What to Do:

- Avoid any outdoor burning.
- Properly discard smoking materials.
- Keep vehicles off dry grass.
- Avoid activities that could create sparks.
