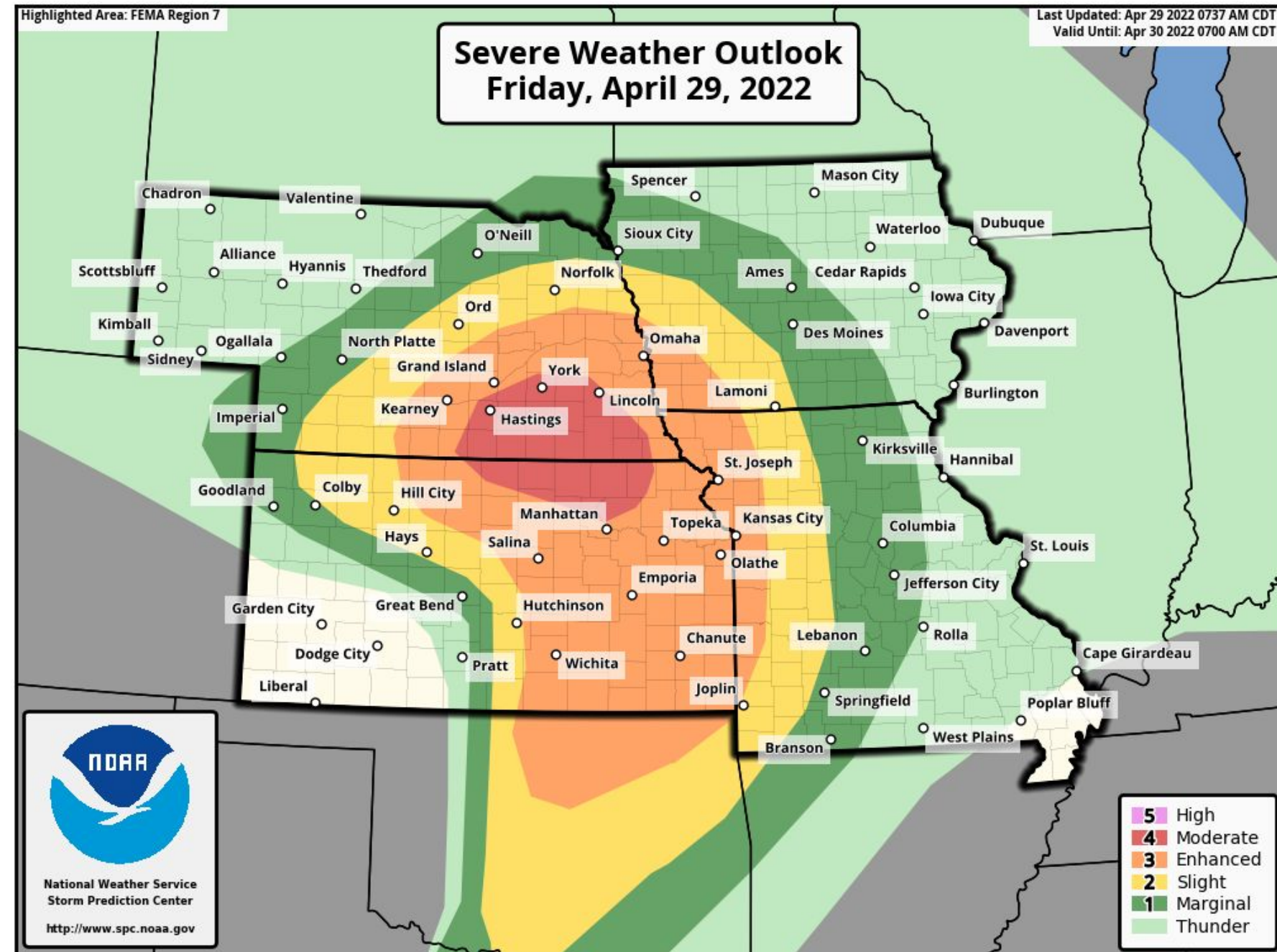
What to Expect:

- Storms develop over central NE then push to the east
- Hail up to the size of golf balls
- Damaging winds
- Flash flooding
- A few tornadoes possible



Timing

→ Greatest threat for severe storms is this evening





Summary

April 29, 2022
7:58 AM



Hazards: Hail up to golf ball size, damaging winds, flash flooding, a few tornadoes possible.



Areas Impacted: Eastern Nebraska and southwest Iowa.



Timing & Duration: The greatest threat will come this evening.



Impacts: Hail large enough to damage cars and roofs.
Winds strong enough to damage trees and powerlines.
Intense thunderstorms could result in flash flooding.

Thunderstorm Wind and Lightning Safety

***When Thunder Roars,
Go Indoors!***



- **Get Inside!**
 - ***substantial shelter***
 - Low lying area
 - Put as many walls between you and the outside
 - Away from windows
 - Avoid contact with electrical or plumbing systems (while lightning is nearby)
 - ***hard topped vehicle (next best choice)***
- **Wait 30 minutes after the last thunder heard to resume outdoor activities, or until warning/advisory has expired**
