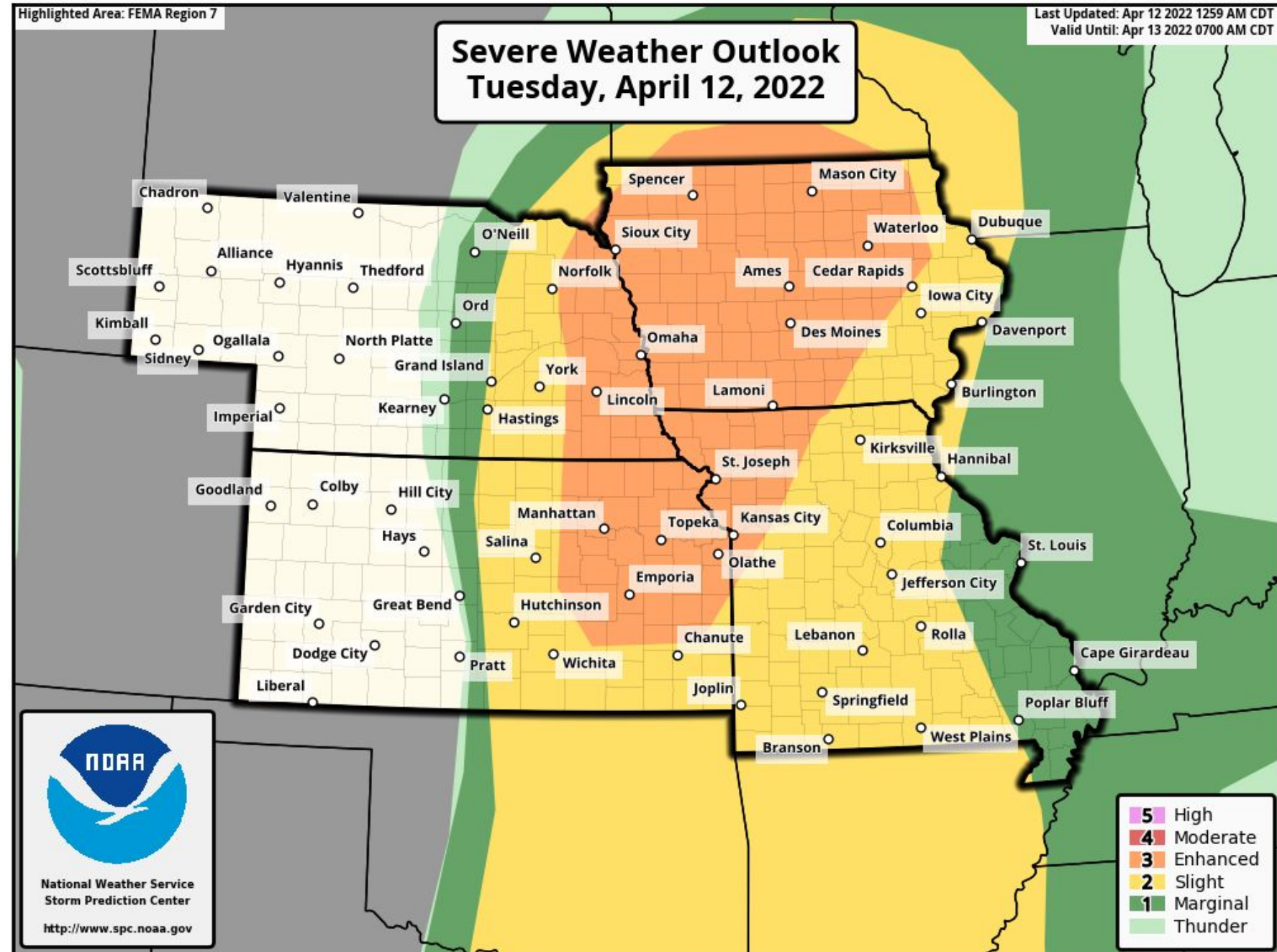

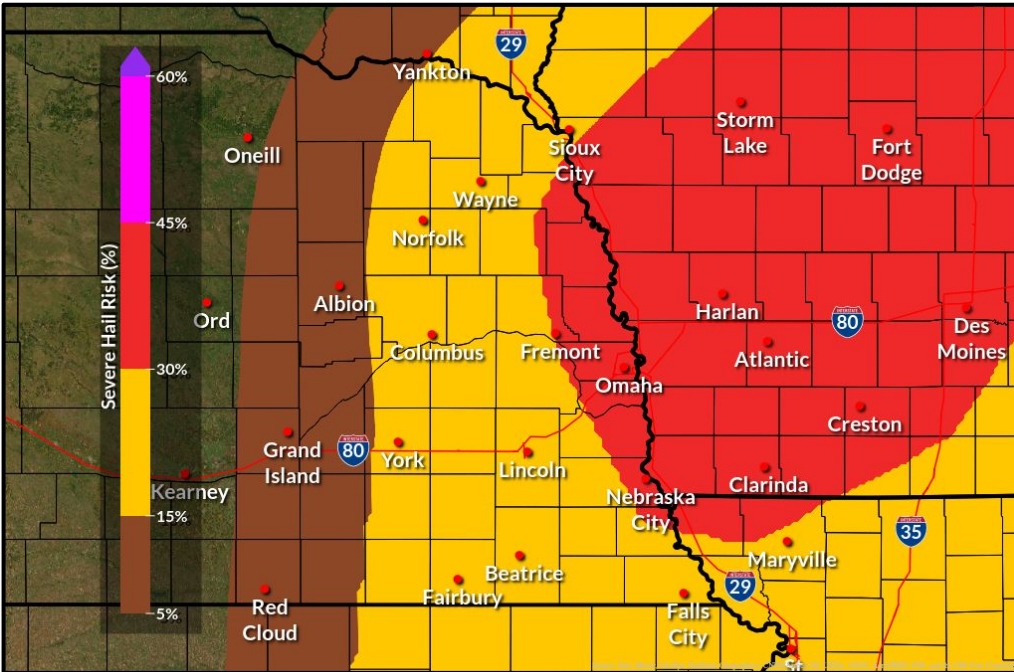
# Severe Weather Threat Breakdown

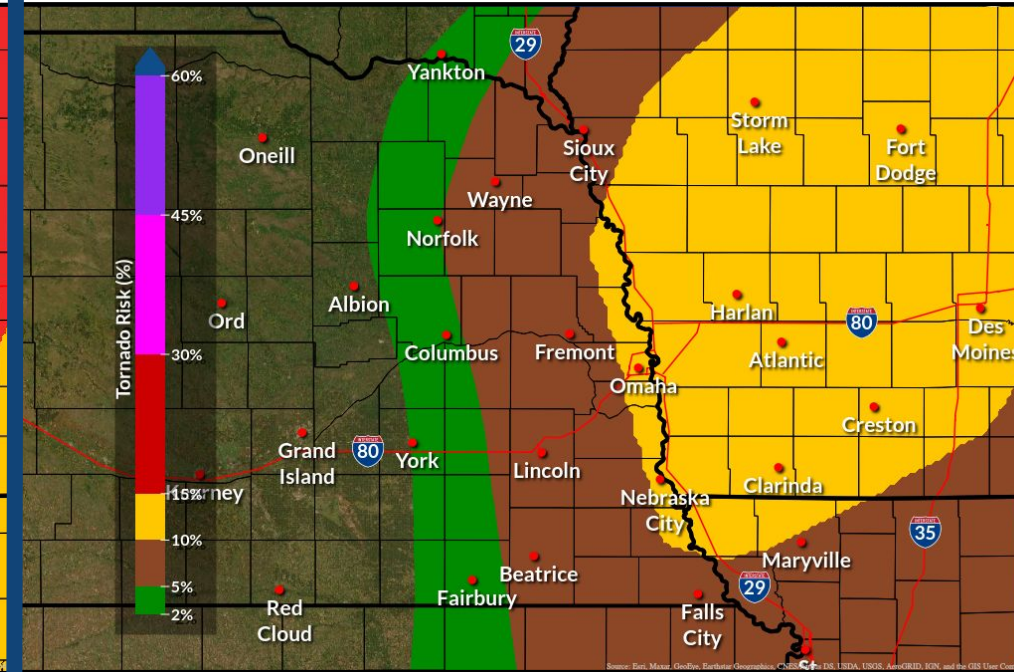
All severe weather hazardous possible this afternoon and evening.



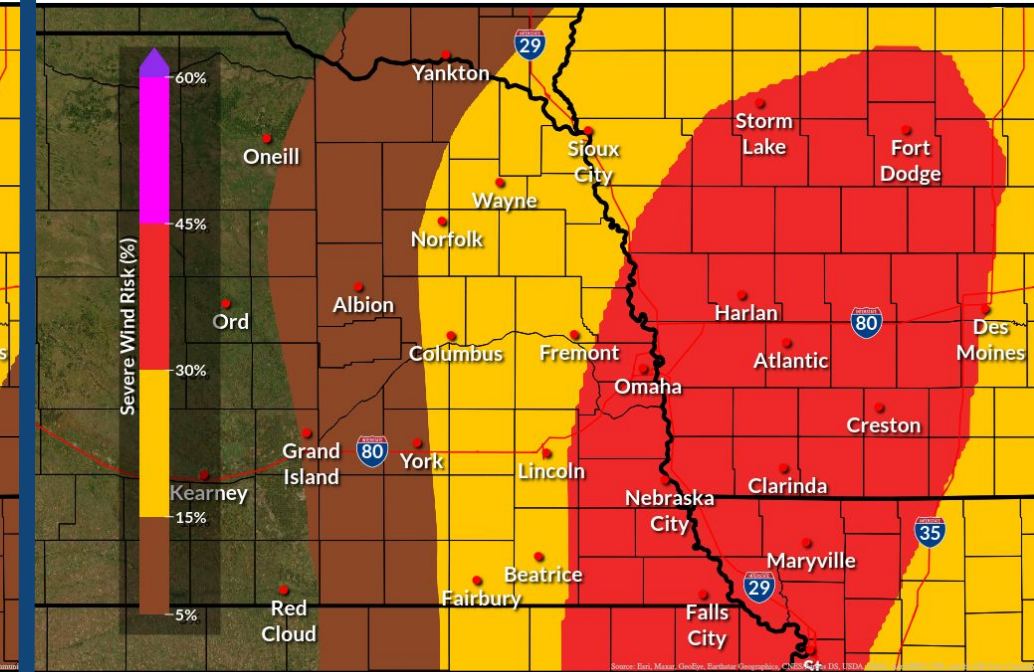
## Tornadoes



## Large Hail



## Damaging Wind



→ Potential for several tornadoes, a few may be strong.

→ Large hail golf ball size or larger possible.

→ Storms may produce wind gusts of 60-70 mph.



**Timing** - Storm chances increase after 4pm. Isolated storms possible between 4-6 PM. After 6 PM, organized line of storms are likely.



**Stay Alert** - Storms will be moving very fast. Weather conditions may change rapidly and necessitate quick action.





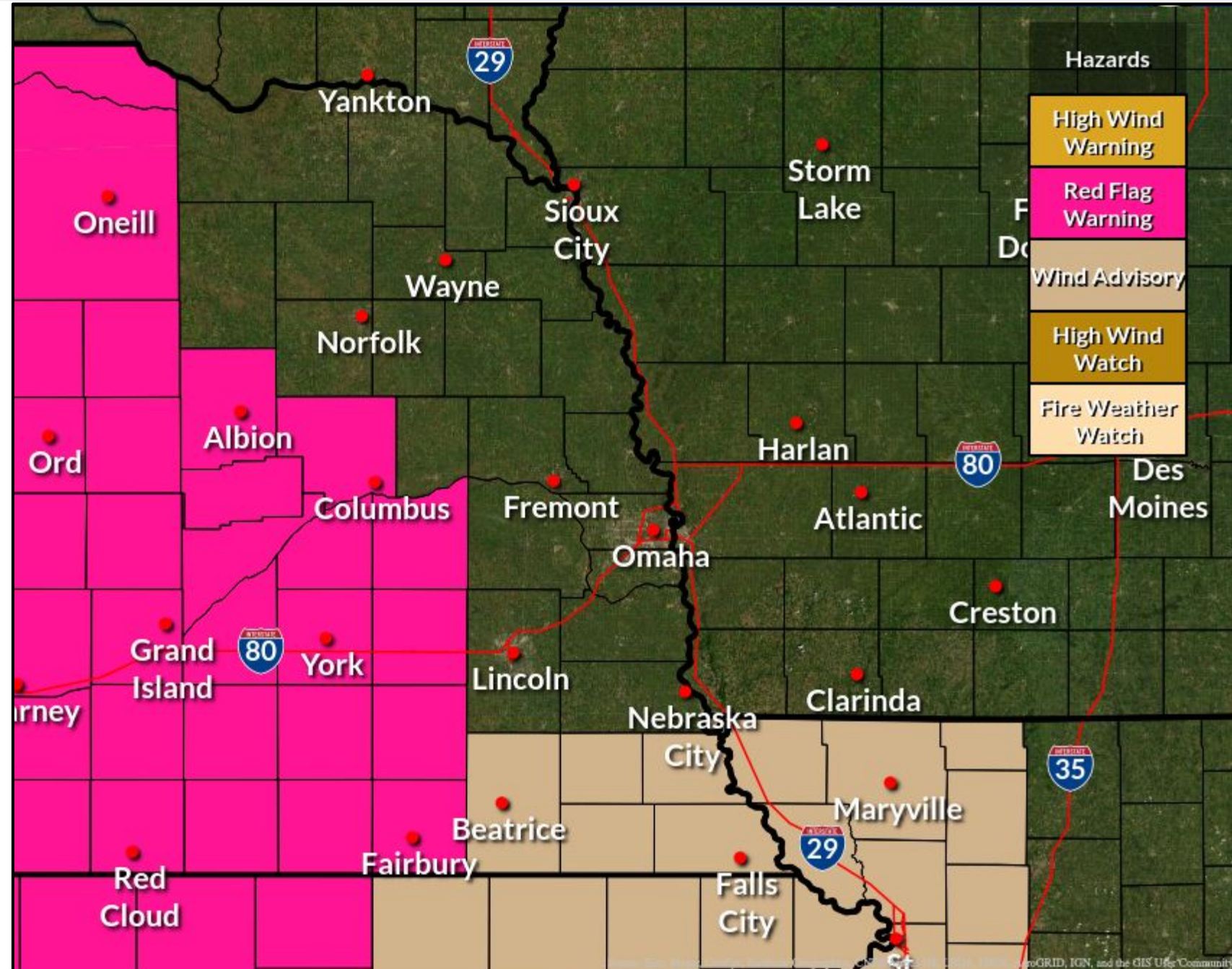
# Very High to Extreme Fire Danger Tuesday

April 12, 2022  
5:00 AM

Fire Weather Watch/Red Flag Warning: Noon through 8 PM

## Key Messages:

- Extreme fire danger Tuesday in central Nebraska
- Any fires that start will be very difficult to control
- Outdoor burning should be avoided
- Wind Advisory in effect for far southeast Nebraska.
- Relative Humidity as low as 20 percent

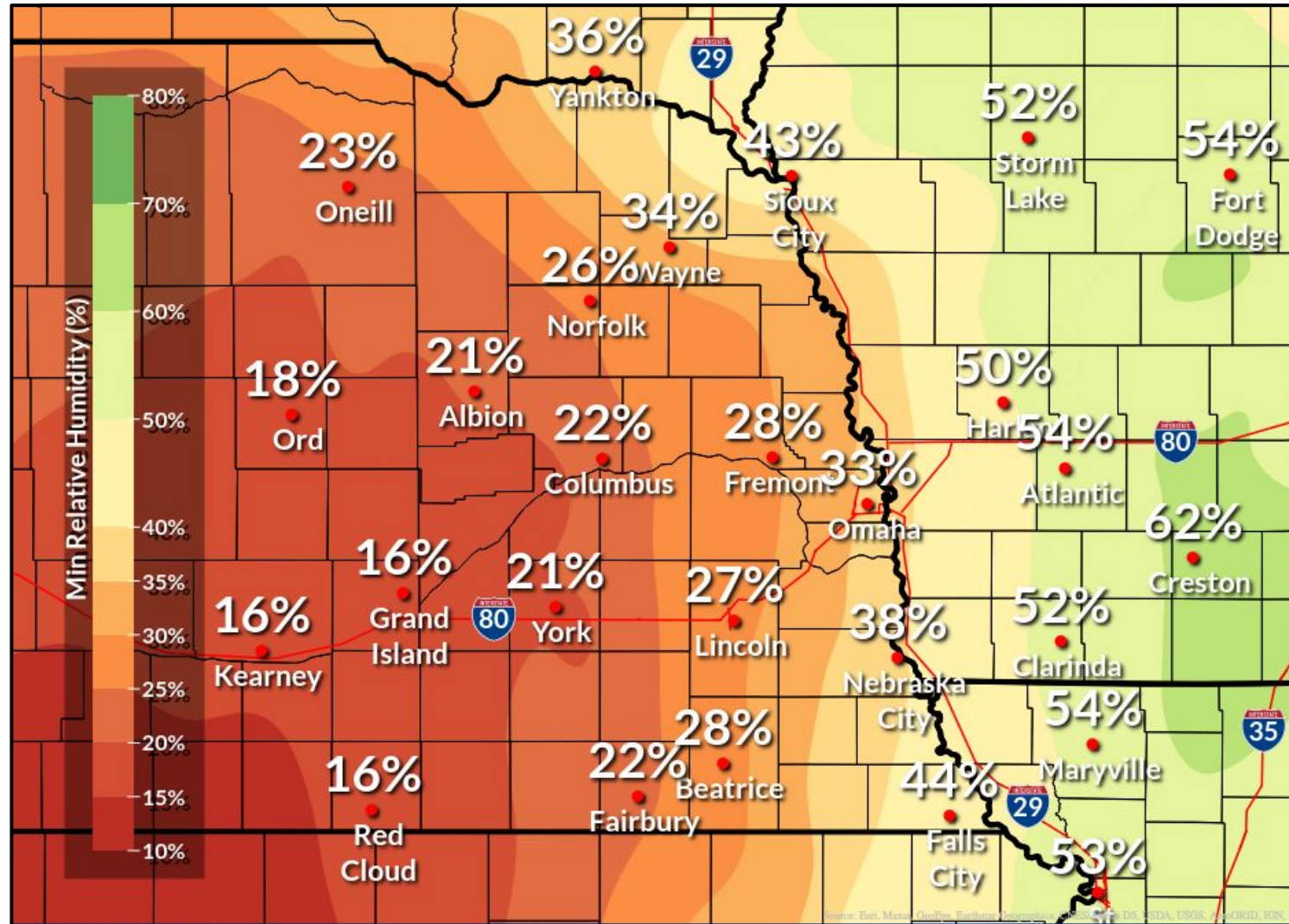




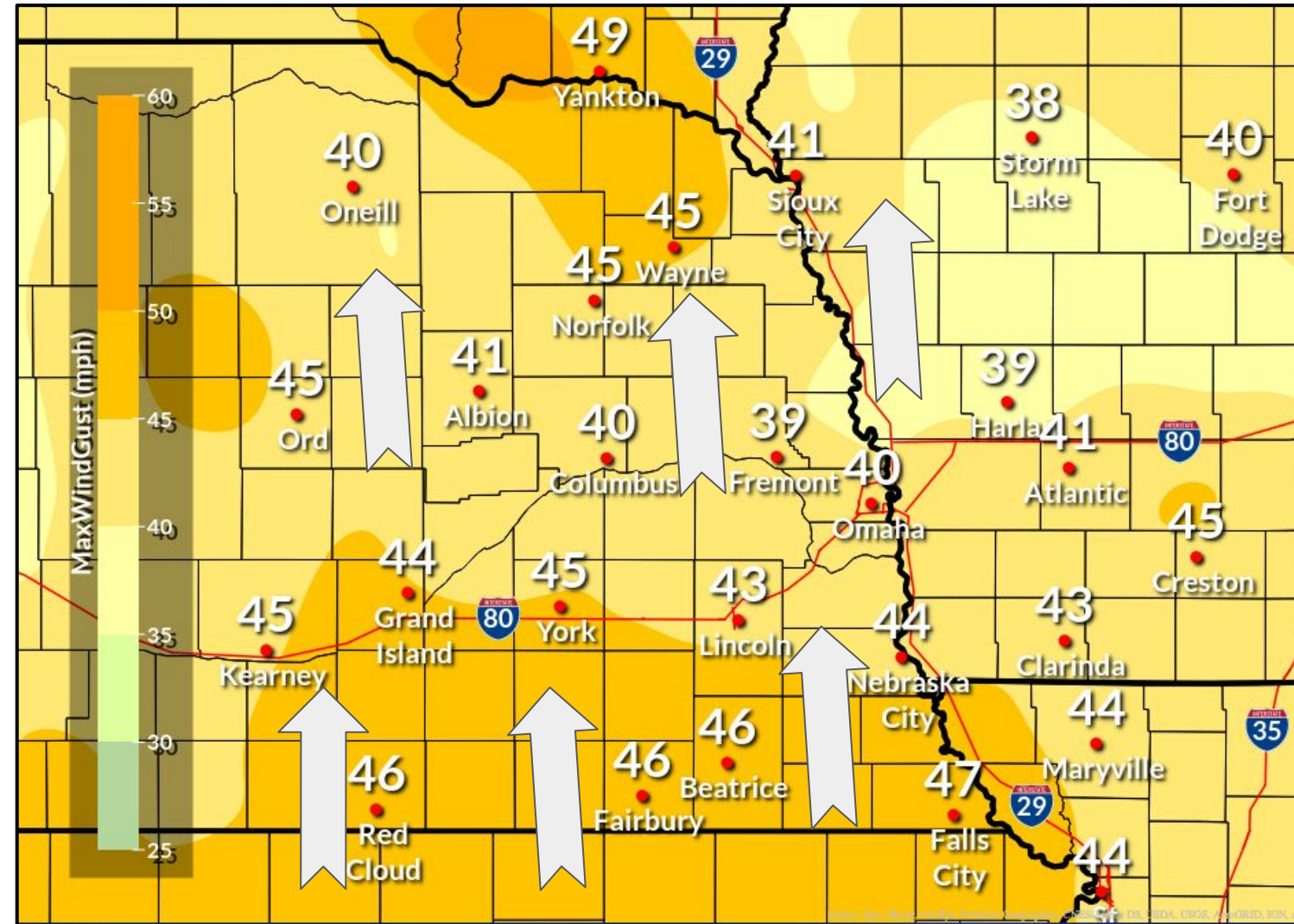
# Minimum Relative Humidity & Max Wind Gusts Today

# Severe Weather Risk Late Tuesday

April 12, 2022  
2:48 AM

Enhanced risk for severe weather including tornadoes, large hail, and damaging wind.

## Timing



Isolated Storms 4-6 PM  
Line of Storms 6 PM - Midnight

## Actions



Be weather aware and ready to act.  
Have multiple ways to receive warning information!

A few could be strong



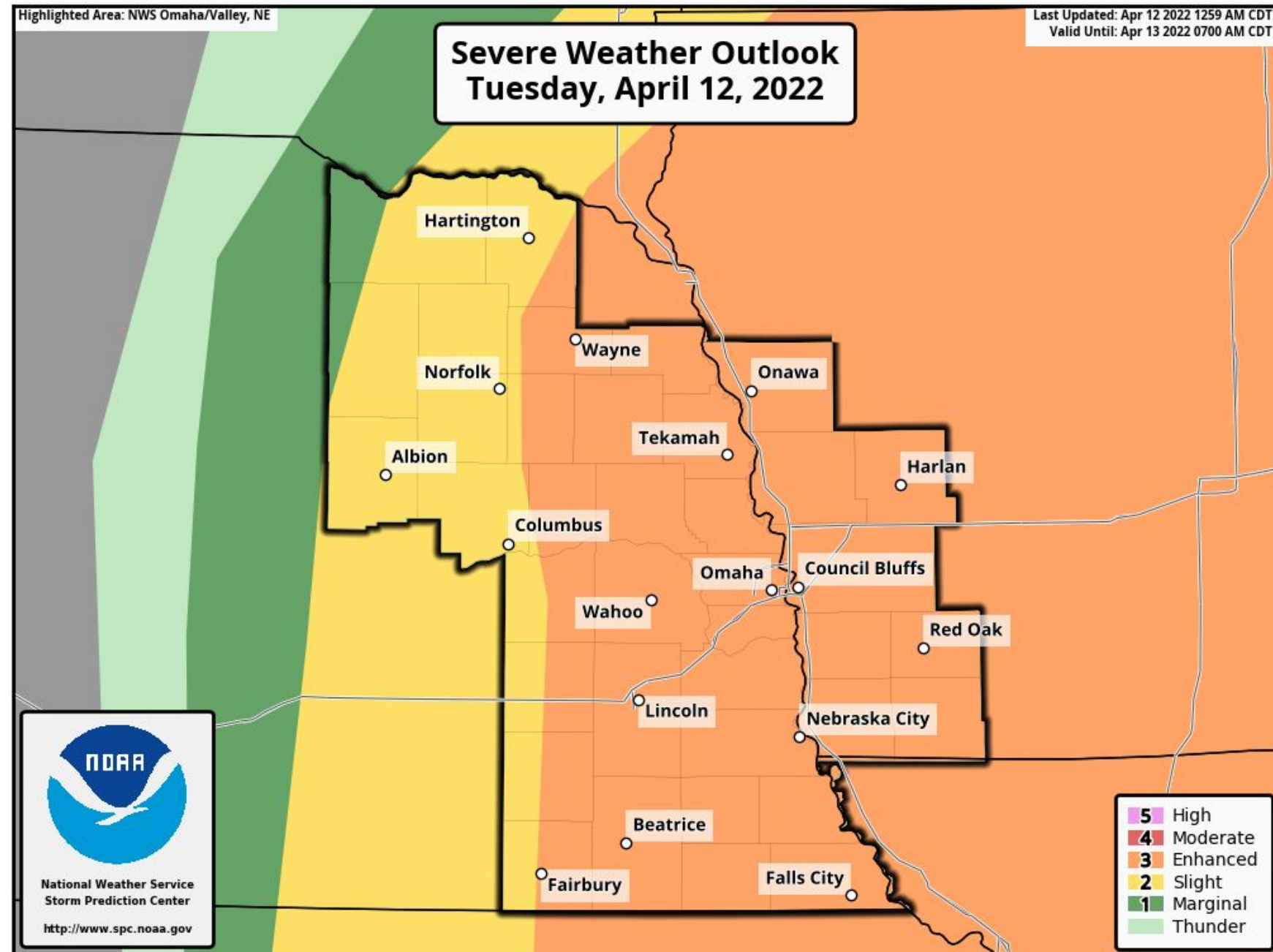
### Large Hail

Golf Ball size or larger possible



### Damaging Wind

Strong gusts of 60-70mph

### Know Where to Go

*When Sheltering from a Tornado*

Top floor rooms DO NOT protect you.

Exterior rooms and rooms with windows DO NOT protect you.

NO PLACE OUTSIDE is safe from a tornado.

If you have no basement, move to an interior room with no windows.

Quickly move to your basement and bring your emergency supply kit.
