- Hail up to two inches.
- Damaging winds up to 60 mph.
- A few tornadoes possible.




Timing:

→ The greatest threat for severe storms in our area today is 2 pm to 7 pm.




Individual Hazard Outlooks Today


Tornado Probability

58 mph Severe Wind Probability






Hot and Humid Weather

Potential Max Heat Index This Afternoon



- Heat index values should range in the 90s this afternoon.
- Make sure to stay hydrated today.
- Take frequent breaks in the shade if working or exercising outdoors.
- Similar values could also occur on Thursday.

Potential near-record high temperatures are forecast in Lincoln (94) and Omaha (93) today. If clouds persist more than forecast, temperatures could be a little cooler.

What to Expect:

- Storms develop over central NE during the afternoon and then push east through the evening.
- Hail up to two inches.
- Damaging winds up to 70 mph.
- A few tornadoes possible.
- Locally heavy rains possible.



Timing:

→ The greatest threat for severe storms in our area Thursday is 4pm through Midnight.


Storm Coverage Confidence




Individual Hazard Outlooks Thursday


Tornado Probability

Summary

May 11, 2022
4:31 AM



Hazards: Hail up to hen egg size, damaging winds, and a few tornadoes possible. Locally heavy rains possible Thursday.



Areas Impacted: Eastern Nebraska and Southwest Iowa.



Timing & Duration: 2 pm-7 pm on Today, and 4 pm-Midnight on Thursday.



Impacts: Hail large enough to damage cars and roofs. Winds strong enough to damage trees and powerlines. Isolated tornadoes could also occur.
