Sierra H Broadcasting is an equal opportunity employer and is dedicated to providing broad outreach regarding job vacancies at the stations. Sierra H Broadcasting has included language on their station websites and on-air broadcasts to inform the general public of career opportunities available in the broadcasting industry.

Members of our stations often speak to various educational institutions and community organizations regarding career opportunities in radio and their experience in the broadcast industry. On-air staff spoke to the audio class at Millennium High School on March 3, 2023 for their career day. On-air staff participated in the career panels at Paradise Valley Community College on February 15, 2023 (society & culture) & March 28, 2023 (visual & performing arts). On-air talent employees participated in interviews with Allaccess.com June 7, 2022 & November 15, 2022. They discussed their careers and experience in radio broadcasting. On-air talent spoke to students at Bostrom High School on November 30,2022, Laveen Elementary School on March 10, 2023, and ASU Preparatory Academy on December 9, 2022 & March 24, 2023. The students were able to engage with the talent and ask questions regarding radio broadcasting. On air talent and staff also participated in The Phoenix Kidney Walk on April 16, 2023, UMOM walk May 06, 2023 and Picnic in the Park on March 12, 2023, as radio representatives of the stations. Throughout the year, employees attended the Local First Arizona mixers and the AZ Hispanic Chamber of Commerce events. They engage with members as a broadcast representative discussing community collaboration, and creative ways to connect students and professionals to a variety of events and educational opportunities using the reach of media.

During the reporting period, the stations also participated in three job fairs. These job fairs include: The Paradise Valley Community College (PVCC) Career Fair held on October 12, 2022, at the PVCC Phoenix, AZ campus. The Grand Canyon University (GCU) Marketing Agencies & Firms Career Fair held on November 1,2022 at the Colangelo College of Business campus. The ASU Spring 2023 Career & Internship Fair held February 22, 2023, at the Tempe, AZ campus. HR Manager, Sales Manager & Promotions Director were in attendance at these events and spoke with participants to answer questions regarding careers in radio broadcasting. Attendees were directed to our website to apply. Human Resources spoke with the Grand Canyon University project manager on December 8, 2022 regarding partnership opportunities for GCU students and Sierra H Broadcasting.

Sierra H Broadcasting provides internship programs for college students in the fields of promotions/marketing, programming, business, engineering and sales. The stations maintain an internship program that runs throughout the year including Spring, Summer, Fall and Winter semesters of the college school year. College students are provided an opportunity to work with the stations and earn college credit for real world experience. The station provides the necessary information to the schools so that students receive earned credit and students receive guidance under the supervision of one or several station managers. Programs are typically 13 weeks in duration. During the reporting period the stations had a total of five interns. The interns were for promotions, marketing and business. They worked directly with the Business Manager and Promotions/ Marketing Manager learning the job and experiencing their career of interest in a professional environment. Sierra H Broadcasting continues to actively recruit for interns in all department.

Sierra H Broadcasting offers tours to schools, youth groups, community groups and other entities to provide information about the broadcasting industry and careers in the broadcasting industry to the public and to students. Station tours included listener walk-ins on June 21, 2022, individuals interested in employment on April 25,2023 and Touchstone Behavioral Health students on site recording commercial spots to name a few. Throughout the year various groups and individuals tour our stations upon request.

Sierra H Broadcasting actively participates in the Arizona Broadcaster Association helping to serve. advocate, and educate the community regarding the Broadcast industry. Sierra H Broadcasting Traffic Manager actively works with the ABA on their statewide PSA campaign programs.

Sierra H Broadcasting has an internal mentorship policy in which all employees may learn any aspect of radio that is outside of the employee's current job responsibility. This allows the employee to acquire the skills necessary to qualify for other positions, including higher level positions. At the employee's request, a mentor in the area in which the employee wishes to learn will train the employee and expose him or her to the skills, knowledge and competency necessary for the job. During the reporting period several members of our staff participated in the station's mentorship program as either a mentor or mentee.

Upon hire, and annually, managers and supervisors are trained on EEO guidelines and various employment issues. This year's annual training was held on September 23, 2022, with a focus on implicit unconscious bias. These sessions provide training to management level personnel responsible for ensuring the stations compliance with Federal EEO rules and regulations and fair hiring practices.

Sierra H Broadcasting staff attended year-round training designed to enable employees to acquire the skills necessary to become successful in this highly competitive market. During the reporting period, additional training included: The National Sales Manager attended The Radio Masters Sales Summit in Miami, Florida from September 22-23, 2022. The sales team participated in the Nielsen Qualitative training virtually on April 11,2023. The sales associates also

participate in various live, role-playing exercises on a weekly basis. From the programming department, the Program Director has attended and disseminated to staff several professional development opportunities, including The Jacobs Media Tech Survey 2023 webinar on May 10, 2023. These trainings covered everything from morning show strategies to playlist development, and social media and streaming best practices. As an ongoing element, the Program Director subscribes to Tracy Johnson Radio Insiders, a programmer's tool, and resource for talent development. All Staff attended and or reviewed the 2023 Arizona Media Research study webinar provided by the Arizona Broadcasters Association in collaboration with Smith Geiger Research on May 10, 2023. This study informed our staff on how Arizonians consume media, which will help Sierra H with strategic efforts to benefit our audience, clients, and community. The Business Manager participates in monthly business management coaching provided by AZ Growth Advisors located in Phoenix, AZ. Coaching involves helping businesses achieve their growth goals, through highly effective leaders.
