

Student Art Contest – Grades 3 & 7

Saskatoon Transit is striving to create a sense of community and youthful atmosphere by hosting its 2nd annual Student Art Contest. Grades 3 and 7 will participate as they both discuss Public and Active Transportation as part of their curriculum. A winner from each grade will be chosen, and their art will be displayed on city Transit buses throughout the summer.

What we are looking for

Original art that celebrates *Active Transportation* and all the modes that exist in Saskatoon. (I.e. public transit, cycling, walking, car sharing, taxis, car-pooling, uber, etc... and their combination with each other aka multi-modal).

Guidelines

- Art:
 - Art can be submitted individually or collaboratively as a group or class
 - Size should be between 139"x30" and 51"x11" (six 8.5" x 11 sheets taped together – portrait side-by-side. We can work with any horizontal dimension but it may be slightly edited.
 - Can incorporate pencil crayons, crayons, markers, paint etc. but should not be 3D (nothing glued on)
 - May include text, diagrams or pictures but may not use any offensive images, language or commercial slogans
 - Can and should incorporate color
 - On the back include: name, grade, school, title of piece
 - Artwork will not be returned
 - Copyright of the artwork will remain with the artist. Saskatoon Transit and the City of Saskatoon retain the right to use images for promotional purposes
- Submission:
 - All art work must be completed and submitted to teacher by 3:30 p.m. **May 30, 2018.**
 - Teachers must email transit.services@saskatoon.ca by **May 30** to let us know a pick up is required. Art will be picked up from each school's main office on May 31st.
- Judging:
 - Winners will be chosen for how well the art fits the theme and "best captures the spirit of active transportation."
- Timeline
 - May 30 Deadline for submissions /deadline to let Transit know you have submissions
 - May 31 Art pick up
 - June 25 Winner Press Conference
