- A genuine interest & involvement in extra-curricular activities and/or self-initiated undertakings related to community involvement and/or volunteer work.

- A willingness to assist others.

How to Apply

- 1) Submit a short one-page essay (about 500 words), why you're taking a broadcasting course, what your career goal is, and how one of these scholarships will help you attain that goal. Also read this essay as a video on YouTube, Vimeo, etc.
- 2) Submit a Resume with headings:
 - Education
 - Employment history
 - Activities and Interests (awards, memberships, sports teams, volunteer work, etc.)
 - Names of 3 references (with occupation & phone #)
- 3) A copy of an official high school or college transcript.
- 4) A letter of recommendation from any of the following: professional person, teacher, professor, counselor or clergy member, who is familiar with your academic and/or community involvement.

AWARDING of SCHOLARSHIPS

Only those applicants who are awarded scholarships will be contacted by **July 31st**.

Scholarships must be used exclusively for tuition of the Broadcasting Programs offered by Western Academy. The Scholarship will be applied to the final installment payments of tuition.

People who have been awarded Scholarships must also submit an Application to Enroll at Western Academy (if they haven't done so already).

Applications for Enrollment are available by attending an "Open House" session at Western Academy. The presentation includes the following topics:

- explanation of the broadcast training program
- tour through radio & television studios
- all about a career in the media
- job placement and hiring
- interview & audition
- distribution of application forms
